This year in MFL each class has continued to look at the culture, language, food and famous landscapes of our chosen country France. Each class has looked at learning how to greet each other starting with “Bonjour” and progressing to different greetings throughout the day such as “Bonne Nuit” and saying Goodbye “Au revoir”

Each class is allocated a list of numbers and colours to learn so there is progression and development as the children move through the different year groups.
