- In 2017, 2018 and 2019 the % of pupils achieving 2+ levels of progress in English and Maths is consistently greater than 73%. In
 2019 100% of pupils had made at least 2 levels progress between the end of KS1 and the end of KS2 in both Maths and English regardless of cohort.
- This is consistently above expected progress in the National Progression Guidance i.e. 56% for English and 54% for Maths and demonstrates **Outstanding Progress**.

Pupil Premium Progress in English and Maths

- In, 2017, 2018 and 2019 the percentage of pupils in receipt of pupil premium achieving 2+ levels of progress in English and Maths is consistently greater than 78%. In 2018 and 2019 the percentage was 100%
- This is consistently above expected progress in the National Progression Guidance i.e. 56% for English and 54% for Maths.

This demonstrates that the interventions put in place are enabling these pupils to:



- make progress that is as good as or better than their peers
- achieve consistently above expected progress in the National Progression Guidance
